# **Band President**

- The Band President shall be in charge of coordinating with the Directors and Parent Liaison aspects of Band Banquet.
- The Band President must have received a grade of 70 or higher in each class for each six-weeks grading period of the previous school year and will maintain this standard for the duration of his/her time in office.
- One and only one Band President will be elected.
- Juniors, sophomores and freshmen are not eligible to serve as Band President.
- Drum Majors may not run for Band President.

#### **Band Vice President**

- Candidates must be from the junior or senior class.
- Will serve as second in command for the Band Banquet committee, assisting the President in this event.
- The Band Vice President must have received a grade of 70 or higher in each class for each six-weeks grading period of the previous school year and will maintain this standard for the duration of his/her time in office.
- One and only one Band Vice President will be elected.
- Sophomores and freshmen are not eligible to serve as Band Vice President.

### Historian

- Candidates must be from the sophomore, junior, or senior class.
- The Historian must have received a grade of 70 or higher in each class for each six-weeks grading period of the previous school year and will maintain this standard for the duration of his/her time in office.
- Will prepare the slide show for the Band Banquet and will serve on the Band Banquet committee.
- Will take pictures of the band program representing a cross section of the band proper (equal representation of all sections).
- Candidates for Historian may run for office as pairs of running mates. Running mates will be recognized as a single ballot entry and will receive ONE VOTE from each band member, the same as any single candidate.
- Freshmen are not eligible to run for Historian.

#### Class Representative

- Candidates must represent the grade level in which they are enrolled.
- The Class Representative must have received a grade of 70 or higher in each class for the SECOND SEMESTER of the previous school year.
- Color Guard candidates must have served at least one full year as a member in good standing of the Cypress Falls Band in order to run for Class Representative. Therefore, freshman color guard members are not eligible to run for office.
- In the event there is only one candidate for a particular class, that candidate will win by acclamation.
- One and only one Class Representative will be elected per grade level.
- Will serve as class representative on the Band Banquet committee and as class voice in all requests.

## **Color Guard Representative**

- Candidates must have served for a least one full school year and be a current member in good standing of the color guard.
- The Color Guard Representative must have received a grade of 70 or higher in each class for the SECOND SEMESTER of the previous school year.
- The Color Guard Representative must have participated satisfactorily in the marching band and winter guard seasons from the previous school year.
- In the event there is only one candidate for Color Guard Representative, that candidate will win by acclamation PROVIDED he/she meets the eligibility criteria described above.
- One and only one Color Guard Representative will be elected.
- Will serve as Color Guard representative on the Band Banquet committee.

### Percussion Representative

- Candidates must have served for a least one full school year and be a current member in good standing of the percussion.
- The Percussion Representative must have received a grade of 70 or higher in each class for the SECOND SEMESTER of the previous school year.
- The Percussion Representative must have participated satisfactorily in the marching band and concert seasons from the previous school year.
- In the event there is only one candidate for Percussion Representative, that candidate will win by acclamation PROVIDED he/she meets the eligibility criteria described above.
- One and only one Percussion Representative will be elected.
- Will serve as Percussion representative on the Band Banquet committee.
