Comments from Director - Ryan Mohney

- Thanks for being flexible with rain delays at UIL Area; UIL lacked in communicating with Directors; Apologies for not knowing and sharing information sooner.
- Last Blast ends the marching season; to be held November 12 at 7 pm at the Cy-Falls JV Football field; kids call time will be a little earlier; great time to visit and close out show; lots of opportunities to take pictures with your student
- November 8th is out last district football game; Senior Night we will honor all our band seniors; parents will present their senior with a medal on the field during halftime
- Play-off game #1 is November 14th; band is expected to attend and the football team will keep playing until it loses which could take us into the holidays; any student that is able to attend should plan to attend - if you need to miss just let directors know; halftime will be just a spirit performance
- Marching Band will come to an end and Winter Guard, Indoor Drumline and 3 concert bands will start up for end of the year and into spring
- Solo/Ensemble will take place in February; students get to pick their own music and their ensemble; will start discussing in class next week
- Assessments will begin for band placements; students are expected to play their scales;
 week before Thanksgiving break students will be playing their scales for the directors
- After Thanksgiving the band will play etudes for band placements in the Spring
- UIL Region is December 6, 7 or 9; Freshman auditions are on December 9; students who make all state will go to San Antonio in February with all expenses paid.
- Holiday Concert will happen on December 12, 2024 in the Commons with crafts, silent auction, dinner meal, etc.; very family friendly
- Winter Guard meeting on Thursday, November 7th at 7 pm
- I'm very pleased with all students' growth; kids have come very far
